G. FINANCIAL SECURITY REDUCTION FOR T-871 PRELIMANARY/FINAL LOT CONSOLIDATION, SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR 2023 ROUTE 116 W MANCHESTER LLC FOR PROPOSED WAWA FOOD MARKET: Motion to approve the request from Ferber Company to release the performance bond for the project located at 4535 West Market Street. Bond #211522 for the demolition, removals and clearing of the site, erosion control, curb and pavement, striping and signage, storm drainage, stormwater BMPs, sanitary sewer, water and monument markers are currently \$377,991.19. Dawood Engineers has reviewed the request and recommends reducing the financial security by \$237,032.03 and retaining \$140,959.16 which includes the 18-month maintenance guarantee.
