Police Chief's Report for July 2024

July 25th, 2024

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 493 incidents as well as 66 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 472 traffic stops and issued 204 traffic citations. The department made 13 felony arrests, 27 misdemeanor arrests, 24 summary non-traffic arrests and 2 juvenile petitions were filed.

The 2024 Greater York State Fair started on July 26th and will end on July 28th. We have the event properly staffed by our officers as well as law enforcement professionals from the York County Sheriff's Office, Pennsylvania State Police, York County Probation, York Fair Police and others. Police presence will be a deterrent and we feel that it has contributed to the low number of police related issues during the event in the past. We plan on providing the attendees of the event as safe of an experience as possible and hopefully a successful York Fair all the way around.



CI Division Report for July 2024 Board Meeting

6/20/2024 through 7/18/2024

Since June 20, 2024, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 16 new case assignments: 4 PICS cases, 4 ChildLine Referrals for physical abuse/assaults or general endangerment of children, 2 fraud investigations, 2 suspicious deaths, a Megan's Law violation for failure to report a change of address, an employee/internal theft of money, and 2 "Cyber Tip" generated investigations into the alleged possession/sharing of images of child pornography.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 10 investigations: 3 PICS cases, the Megan's Law reporting violation listed above, 4 investigations into physical or sexual abuse of children, an investigation into a found firearm from November of 2022, and an investigation into the placement of card skimmers on a self-checkout at Wal-Mart (in cooperation with the US Secret Service – closed by way of Federal indictment).

Also of note, our office undertook background investigations into two potential candidates for the position of police officer, with one being completed and the second awaiting information from entities/agencies outside the United States.
