#### Police Chief's Report for June 2024

June 27, 2024

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 505 incidents as well as 79 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 407 traffic stops and issued 170 traffic citations. The department made 12 felony arrests, 31 misdemeanor arrests, 29 summary non-traffic arrest and 14 juvenile petitions were also filed.

The department held a planning meeting for the York Interstate Fair and we had a great amount of participation from a number of law enforcement entities and others. We are very confident with the planning process and that the event this year will be well staffed and well attended by our law enforcement partners. Lt. Hanuska led the meeting and did a great job laying out expectations and plans for the Fair this year. We will be assisted by several law enforcement partners again including the Fair Police.

The department has been hit with staffing challenges this year due to injuries and departures of officers. Office Cleck's departure was not planned and we are doing our best to replace his roster spot now. Staffing is a difficult task to manage and when officers are injured or sick it makes even more so. It is a constant challenge and Lt Hanuska does a great job dealing with the schedule and staffing issues we face daily. I am confident that we will be back to normal very soon.

The West York School District met with Officer Laron Woody on June 18<sup>th</sup> at their school district meeting to welcome him to their High School as the new school resource officer. The meeting went well and I am confident that Officer Woody will do a great job for the district and the department in his new role.

### CI Division Report for June 2024 Board Meeting

#### 5/16/2024 through 6/20/2024

Since May 16, 2024, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 11 new case assignments: a PICS case, 4 ChildLine Referrals for both physical and sexual abuse/assaults of children (one of which was a random "stranger" attack and sexual assault of a teenage girl on a walking path within a township community), 2 fraud investigations, 3 connected Retail Theft cases (part of a large volume of cases all turned over at once by Target LP), and a child drowning.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 12 investigations: 3 PICS cases (the one listed above and 2 older cases), the 3 connected Retail Theft investigations listed above, 4 investigations into physical or sexual abuse of children/juveniles, the theft and subsequent access device fraud case listed in last month's report, and an overdose death investigation from October 2023, which resulted in a drug delivery charge.

Also of note, our office is in the process of conducting a background investigation into a candidate for the position of police officer and has handled approximately 2 dozen "background" investigations into subjects applying for solicitation permits in the township.
