- **Highway Department Seasonal and Daily tasks**
 - Potholes identified and patched
 - Clean up after storms and high winds – see attached photos
 - Clogged catch basins identified and cleaned
 - Township buildings maintenance and repairs – Chiller repair, Network repair
 - Road sign maintenance and replacement – Weed control and branch trimming around signs.
 - Maintenance Building safety checks
 - Paving and Line painting start at the end of the month.
 - Vehicle repairs and maintenance
 - Storm water problem areas identified for possible repair
 - Maintenance mowing of ROW started
 - Working with HRG to complete Warick storm water project.
 - Collecting easements for Warwick project
 - Working with HRG to complete Hayden Heights storm water project
 - Working with HRG to complete Westview Manor storm water project, Phase I and Phase II.
 - Birdland micro surfacing complete
 - Zarfoss Rd full depth reclamation and W. King St preconstruction meeting complete, getting ready to start projects.
 - Televised storm sewer pipe on Zarfoss Rd.
 - Sidewalk and road cut inspections
 - Graybill Rd vegetation and garbage clean up

- Sewer Department Seasonal and Daily tasks
 - Respond to sewer clogs
 - PA One Calls and Emergency PA One calls
 - Pump station and Sewer system weekly maintenance and inspections – pump change out at Market St Pump Station.
 - Flow meter projected continued, HRG/ADS
 - Working with HRG to start Market St Pump Station force main replacement.

- Recreation and Parks Department Seasonal and Daily tasks
 - Equipment repair and maintenance
 - Park maintenance (tree trimming, stick clean up etc)
 - Trash and litter control
 - Ball field preparation
 - Sunset Park drainage project – bury pipes and reseed wet area.
 - Set up and tear down at Sunset Park for National night out.
 - Storm and high wind damage, clean up.

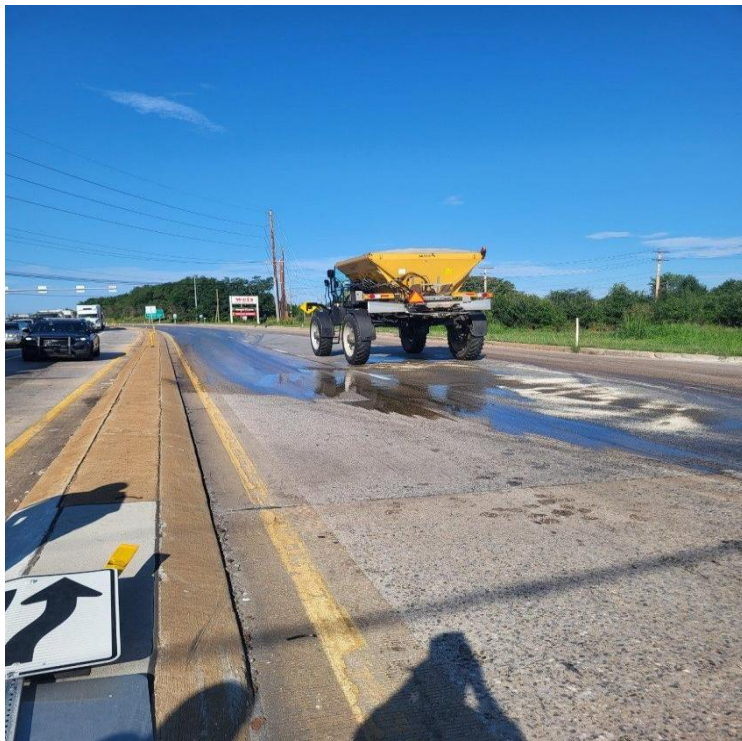
