### VI. NEW BUSINESS

- A. <u>AMERICAN RED CROSS PRESENTATION</u>: American Red Cross would like to present lifesaving awards to those involved with the saving of a drowning victim at Lincolnway Pool during the Labor Day weekend of 2023.
- B. <u>WINDY HILL SENIOR CENTER PRESENTATION</u>: Ms. Tammy Miller and Ms. Jenna Lawrence from the Windy Hill Senior Center will be sharing a presentation to highlight some of the services the center provides, and to thank the Township for its support.
- C. ORDINANCE 24-06 REZONING REQUEST: Motion to approve, revise, table or deny Ordinance 24-06, to rezone a 48.60-acre parcel of land along Baker Road from Open Space Residential to the R-1 Residential Zone. A public hearing was held prior to the Board meeting to allow for questions and comments from the public and Board.
- D. <u>RESOLUTION 24-11 AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE</u>: Motion to approve, revise table or deny Resolution 24-11, an amendment to the Township Comprehensive Plan Update, 2006. This amendment reclassifies the certain parcel located at Baker Road from Open Space Residential-1 to the R-1 Residential zoning.
- E. <u>1760-1765 LEMON STREET ACCESS DRIVE WAIVER REQUEST</u>: Motion to approve, revise, table or deny a request from Mr. Terry Stump for a waiver of the

Access Drive Ordinance §42-8.F which states "the number of access drives intersecting with a street line may not exceed one per lot". Mr. Stump's request is to allow a temporary access drive installed by MYR as part of the Cottontail Solar Hokes 1 project to remain on the site permanently rather than be removed by MYR as required at the completion of the solar energy farm construction. There are currently two (2) permanent access drives depicted on the recorded land development plan. If approved, there will be three (3) access drives onto Lemon Street.

- F. <u>T-893 PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR FRITO LAY YORK ASF REMODEL</u>: Motion to approve, revise, table, or deny a preliminary/final land development plan depicting a proposed 5,478 sq. ft. building expansion on a 12.94 acre parcel located at 3553 Gillespie Drive in the I-3 General Industrial Zone.

  GAS 'N GO 1800 ROOSEVELT AVENUE: Motion to approve, revise, table or deny a
  request from Joseph M. Gurney, RLA, PLA of First Capitol Engineering on behalf of
  the Applicant, Weis Markets Gas 'N Go, to forward a sewer planning module
  exemption mailer to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for a
  project located at 1800 Roosevelt Avenue (Tax Map: JH; Parcel: 19F0C0001) in the
  Highway Commercial Zone. The applicant is proposing to add an employee
  restroom to the gas kiosk for 1 additional EDU to flow to the PA American Water
  sewer treatment facility (former York City Wastewater Treatment Plant).
