### **Bulk Item Guidelines**

#### **ACCEPTED MATERIALS** –

Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied).

#### NON-ACCEPTABLE

MATERIALS — Electronic Waste (computers, televisions, etc.) chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete). To properly dispose of these items please contact the York County Resource Recovery Center at 845-1066 or www.ycswa.com.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS — Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

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Guidelines

## Basic Residential Trash & Recycling Guidelines

All items must be curbside **BEFORE** 6 AM on the day of your collection.

The safe rule of thumb is put it out the night before.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- For any issues/questions regarding your collection, or to order mobile carts please contact the Township office at 717-792-3505. If your trash/recycling is not collected by 4 p.m. on your pickup day, please notify the Township immediately.
- For collection delays and updates, please sign up for the Township text alert by texting "Hello" to 1-855-976-9968. You can also receive email notifications from Penn Waste by visiting their website and signing up.

#### TRASH GUIDELINES

- Effective January 1, 2025, one, 64-gallon mobile cart will be collected two times a week on your specified collection day. All residents and commercial businesses utilizing Township trash must use a Penn Waste provided mobile cart. As of January 1st, trash bags and other garbage cans will not be collected curbside. Penn Waste will still accept additional bags if you purchase and place on your extra bag an orange sticker. These stickers cost \$2.00 and are available at all Rutter's in the Township and the Weis Market on White Street.
- Mobile carts, extra bags, and large items cannot be sitting against any personal property of the homeowner. Example: mailbox, car, lamp post, utility pole, etc. Items against property will not be collected.
- No Construction Debris will be collected curbside.

#### **RECYCLING GUIDELINES**

- Effective January 1st, all residents and commercial businesses utilizing Township recycling must use a Penn Waste provided mobile cart for all your recycling items.
- Plastic bags will NO LONGER be accepted as the facility cannot process them.
- Recycling is collected <u>once</u> a week on your specified collection day.
- Please refer to page 6, for recycling guidelines.
- Please refer to page 8, for the Yard Waste calendar and page 7, for yard waste guidelines.

#### **BULK ITEM GUIDELINES**

- Bulk items are collected once a week on your <u>second</u> collection day. Please refer to page 4, for guidelines. Bulk items are collected by a different truck and will typically get picked up in the afternoon.
- If laying a large item out that contains glass, please put tape in an "X" shape on both sides of glass.
- Effective January 1, 2025, tires without a rim will require an additional \$2.00 sticker to be purchased and placed on the tire for bulk collection.

By law, as of January 24, 2013, Penn Waste is not allowed to collect your electronic waste.

The Covered Devices Recycling Act prohibits residents and businesses from placing their electronic waste at the curb or in their trash.

Covered devices include: desktop computers, laptops, monitors, computer peripherals (keyboard, mouse, printer, and speakers), televisions, or e-readers that browse the internet.



### Yard Waste Collection Guidelines

### Grass Clippings

Grass clippings are not permitted in your trash or yard waste pick up. The best option is to use a mulching mower and let your grass clippings work for you. Mulched grass provides moisture and nitrogen to keep your lawn looking great. If you don't have a mulching mower, low-cost conversion kits are available that fit most mowers. Another idea is to place grass clippings on your vegetable garden or around your hedges. You can also add grass clippings in a backyard compost bin. There are many varieties of bins in stores or you can make a bin of your own. As a last resort, take your grass to the Resource Recovery Center (minimum \$20 waste disposal fee). The Resource Recovery Center is located at 2651 Blackbridge Road, York, PA 17406. Additionally, please remember to remove any grass clippings that may have been blown into the road. This causes an extreme danger to people riding motorcycles and bicycles. Another issue with grass clippings is they clog up storm drains, causing drainage and flooding issues. The best way for homeowners to avoid costly lawsuits and increased homeowners insurance premiums is to discharge towards your home and away from the road.

## How to Prepare Yard Waste

Prepare yard waste with any of these options:

- 1 In a container, which can be emptied
- 2 In a biodegradable paper bag
- 3 Bundle it with biodegradable twine

If you choose to bundle your yard waste, please follow these instructions:

- Bundles are no longer than 5 ft. in length
- Bundles not to exceed 30 lbs. each
- Branches not to exceed 6 inches in diameter

An unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb on the scheduled pick up day before 6:00 AM.

Observed holidays are noted in RED. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day. EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there is no change in service prior to or after the holiday.

### Electronics Recycling

The York County Solid Waste Authority's Residential Electronics Recycling Program is free and open to York County residents ONLY and is conducted Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to noon at the Small Load Drop-off Facility at the York County Resource Recovery Center. Please note: The Small Load Drop-off Facility is located within the York County Resource Recovery Center campus. The Resource Recovery Center is located at 2651 Blackbridge Road. Enter the Resource Recovery Center's main gate entrance and proceed to the scales. You will be directed to the Small Load Drop-off Facility. If you are recycling a large item that will require more than one person to unload it, please bring a helper with you, as Authority assistance with unloading is not guaranteed. ### West Manchester Project Receives State Assistance

State Representative, Seth Grove announced West Manchester Township will receive \$624,828 in state financial assistance for our storm sewer improvements project.

Representative Grove stated, "Unfunded federal mandates, especially around the Chesapeake Bay Watershed continue to drive up the cost of storm water projects to be considered. This award will help the township keep local taxes low by offsetting some of the cost associwated with the Hayward Road storm water project."

Township Manager, Kelly Kelch explained

"Representative Grove has been vital in helping to secure state funds in order to improve the quality of life for residents in West Manchester Township,"

"Because of Grove's efforts, the Township will be receiving \$624,828 in state funds to address both surface flooding and sanitary sewer issues on Warwick and Hayward Roads in West Manchester

Township. This is just one of several grants Representative

Grove has been instrumental in helping the Township acquire over the last several years, we are extremely fortunate to have him representing us in Harrisburg."

This project involves the construction of a 1,590 LF of stormwater conveyance system along Warwick Road, North Drive and Hayward Road. This new system will replace an old/damaged system subject to exfiltration and lacks peak flow capacity causing surface

flooding. These improvements will provide a change to the system with improved capacity to capture peak stormwater flows, reduce surface flooding, and minimize stormwater infiltration into the adjacent sanitary sewer system.

West Manchester Township's Board of Supervisors along with Township Manager, Kelly Kelch expressed their appreciation for Representative Grove's support in making this project possible and for looking out for our residents by making West Manchester Township a better place to live.



### 5 Easy Steps To Winterize Your Rain Barrel

It only takes 15 minutes, but it could save you a lot of money and headache in the long run to winterize your rain barrel before Pennsylvania's cold winter sets in. These five easy steps will ensure your rain barrel will last for years to come, helping reduce stormwater runoff to your local waters!

- 1) Drain all the water out of the barrel before the first hard freeze
- 2) Detach the barrel from the downspout and reconnect the downspout to send stormwater away from your home. Consider cleaning out your gutters at this time to remove leaves and debris
- 3) Remove hoses and spigots from the rain barrel as desired, remove and clean mesh components
- 4) Rinse the rain barrel to remove any debris built up over the year
- 5) Store the barrel. Bring it inside or keep it out of sunlight and turn it upsidedown to prevent water from entering.

Do not lose your beloved rain barrel to winter's harsh conditions! Winterize it now before the cold sets in.

## Hiring a Contractor?

Once you hire a contractor, but at least three weeks before work is scheduled to begin, the homeowner or the contractor must apply for a permit. Building permits can take up to 15 business days because they are reviewed by a third party agency. If the contractor applies for the permit, the homeowner must ask the contractor for the permit so it may be posted in the window of the residence. If the contractor does not get a permit, the homeowner is still legally responsible.

If you have a question as to whether a permit is needed for the work to be done or if you have a problem with the actual permit, please call the **Zoning Officer**, **Rachelle Sampere**, at 717.792.3505. Be sure of the permit and its cost before you pay a contractor for it!

## What Type of Building Permit Do You Need? (Residential)

West Manchester Township requires permits for many types of construction and building work in residential structures. Some jobs will require only a "Zoning Permit" and other jobs will require a "Building Permit". These are separate permits with their own application forms. Zoning permits fall under Township rules. Building permits are for jobs that fall under the State Building Code and require inspection. Keep in mind permits take time to review and process. Please allow up to seven business days for Zoning permits and three weeks for Building permits.

### Examples of work REQUIRING A ZONING PERMIT:

- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a fence.
- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a shed, unattached carport, or unattached garage, under 1,000 square feet
- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a patio, including paver patio or porch with no roof or walls.
- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a walkway on the property other than the sidewalk along the street. (This requires a different permit.)
- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a deck where the deck is not more than 30" high.
- Widening, replacing or adding newly paved areas to an existing driveway.

### Examples of work REQUIRING A BUILDING PERMIT:

- Building an addition onto your house, including attached garages and carports.
- Above ground and in ground swimming pools, even "wall-less" and portable pools! Any pool that is deeper than 24" needs a permit. If your pool is taken down every year, you need a permit to put it back up every year.
- Adding a roof to a patio, porch, or deck where the roof is attached to the house.
- Construction, replacing and/or installation of a deck where the deck is more than 30" from the ground.
- Installation of doors and windows if the new doors and windows are of a different size.
- Upgrading an electrical service.
- The addition or relocation of electrical wiring.
- Plumbing work where the "trap" seal is broken.

### Examples of work NOT REQUIRING ANY PERMIT:

- Repair to existing structures such as floorboards in a deck.
- Putting new shingles on your roof.
- Replacing or installing siding on a house.
- Replacing windows and doors with new ones of the same size.
- Replacing a garage door (however, replacing a manual door with an electric door will require an electrical permit).
- Wallpaper, carpet, tile, paint, and interior cabinetry such as kitchen cabinets.

### Snow And Ice On Sidewalks

Do not shovel or blow snow into public streets. It is against the law, defeats the purpose of snow plowing, and causes unsafe conditions for all drivers. All shoveled or blown snow should be piled in your yard or property.

To remove snow properly, snowplows may make several trips up your street. We recommend you do not shovel the end of your driveway open until the street is completely open and the truck has moved on.

Any person owning property along a street or highway in West Manchester Township is required to remove the snow and ice from the sidewalks at least 24 inches wide for the entire length of their property. The path must be cleared within eight hours after the snow/ice has stopped. If the snow/ice stops after 10 PM, sidewalks must be cleared by 10 AM the next morning.

Snow and ice may NEVER be thrown, pushed, cast, blown, shoveled, plowed or dumped into the street.

\* The above violations may result in a fine up to \$600. \*

### Park Rules

WEST MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP WELCOMES YOU TO USE OUR PARKS. THANKS FOR KEEPING THE PARK A BEAUTIFUL, FUN AND SAFE PLACE.

Please read and abide by the rules, as set forth by Ordinance 85-5.

PARK HOURS ARE DAWN TO DUSK

- Alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are not permitted.
- Golf practice is not permitted.
- ♦ Loud, boisterous or indecent conduct is not permitted.
- Use proper trash receptacles. Don't be a litter bug!
- Vandalism, graffiti, or destruction of any equipment will not be tolerated.
- Motorized model airplanes, skateboards, roller blades, skates, or any motorized, wheeled vehicles are not permitted.
- No open fires except in charcoal grills; dispose of hot coals, ashes in the designated areas.
- ♦ No soliciting of any food or services in the park.
- Speed limit at all parks is 15 mph. Park in designated areas only.
- Reservations for these facilities may be made in advance through the township office.
- For rental costs and additional information, please refer to page 13.
- ♦ If you see any violation of any of the above rules, please call 911.
- ♦ All violations are punishable by a fine and/or imprisonment.

### Refund Policy

- Full refunds will be given for classes canceled by the Parks and Recreation Department.
- Refunds will only be issued to the person who paid the fee.
- No cash refunds.
- Refunds may be prorated.
- Refunds will be by Township check and will be paid in accordance with the Finance Department's regular payment schedule.
- There will be no refunds after the registration deadline unless a participant offers extenuating circumstances or a medical excuse.
- Requests for a refund must be submitted in writing.
- All refunds incur a \$10 processing fee.
- Refunds for trips are issued only if the seat can be resold or the trip is canceled by the Recreation Department.

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### Facility Reservations

The Recreation Department is announcing the following facility reservation fees. Residents are asked to call the Recreation Department at 792-3505 to schedule the use of one of the facilities for your upcoming picnics, family reunions, etc. These fees will help us to properly maintain and control our facilities while offering our residents the opportunity to use them for a planned event. If a pavilion is reserved, the park and its other facilities such as baseball/ softball fields, volleyball and basketball courts are still available for use by the public.

Responsible ownership is the key. We ask that everyone abide by the following rules:

- Dogs are permitted in Dunedin, Sunset Lane, Westgate Park & Little Conewago Conservation Area Parks Only. Pets are not permitted in any other Township Park.
- Dogs must be vaccinated against rabies and display a current license.

  Dogs must be confined, leashed, or otherwise under the physical control of a person at all times.
- Dogs may not be tied to trees, bushes, tables, shelter facilities, even when the owners are present.
- Dogs must be well-behaved at all times.
- Dog owners are required to pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings in trash receptacles.
- Pets may not create a disturbance or nuisance. Excessive barking is a disturbance. Owners may be asked to remove dangerous or noisy pets from the park.

### Rent A Kid Program

This program provides an opportunity for middle and high school students, in grades 7 through 12, to assist older adults in completing routine light-duty household chores and yard work such as mowing lawns and shoveling snow. The goal of the Rent-A-Kid program is not only to get an important job done, but also to foster friendships between older adults and youth.

Adults age 60 and older in need of assistance with chores can call the Rent-A-Kid coordinator who will provide names and phone numbers for youth in their area. It is the responsibility of the older adult to contact the youth and discuss the job to be done, when it is to be done, the rate of pay for the job, and any other arrangements that need to be made.

**Recommended pay rate is at least minimum** wage. However, depending on the type of work and the ability of the older adult to pay, the youth may negotiate a more satisfactory rate of pay.

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### Sewer/Trash Payment

## DO NOT MAIL OR BRING PAYMENTS TO THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE.

West Manchester Township offers the following methods for paying your sewer bill. One of the three options must be used. NO PAYMENTS ARE ACCEPTED AT THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE.

- 1. Credit or Debit Card Please visit our website at <a href="www.wmtwp.com">www.wmtwp.com</a> and click on the Civic Pay Payment Portal link, which is located in the left hand side of the main page to process your payment. You can set up Auto Pay through the Civic Pay Payment Portal. A phone payment can be made by calling 717-801-1219. You will need your account number.
- 2. Automated Clearing House (ACH) or direct debit - The Township can direct debit a checking or savings account for your quarterly sewer/ trash payments. To set this up, go to our website at <a href="https://www.wmtwp.com">www.wmtwp.com</a> and go to forms, click on the <u>Automatic</u> <u>Debit Form</u> and complete it. Please return the form along with a **voided check** to the Township. This form must be returned **ONE** month prior to the quarterly billing cycle to ensure your account will be debited properly. You must notify us immediately if your account number or any changes occur with the account to be debited. Failure to notify us will result in late fees and a nonsufficient fund charge applied to your account.
- 3. Mail mail your check with your account number along with your coupon to the our lock box at the following address:



#### When will I receive my tax bill?

- Real Estate tax bills are mailed to taxpayers in mid-February by the York County Treasurer's Office.
- School tax bills are mailed to taxpayers at the end of June.
- \*All taxpayers will receive a copy of their tax bill regardless of their escrow status. If your taxes are escrowed, contact your mortgage provider to see if they would like you to forward a copy of the bill.

If paying the County/Municipal Real Estate tax bill AND School tax bill at the same time, please make sure they are on separate checks. One check for County/Municipal tax and one check for the School tax.

If you don't receive a copy of your bill, contact the tax office.

#### To obtain a paid receipt:

- Stop by the tax office during office hours.

#### **January Office Closure**

The tax office will be closed in preparation for the 2025 tax season from January 1st – February 4th. Emails and phone messages will be monitored during this timeframe. Interim bill payments can be made by mail or by using the secure afterhours lock box located outside of the tax office. Appointments are also available by request.

## Free Income Tax Preparation for the 2025 Tax Season

The AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Program is again offering FREE tax service for York County taxpayers, especially adults 50 and older with low or moderate income, during the 2023 tax season.

Last year in York County, nearly 100 volunteers filed more than 4,500 Federal, PA and local income tax returns at 12 different locations throughout York County.

There is no fee and AARP membership is not required.

Taxpayers should bring their photo ID and proof of their

social security or ITIN numbers for anyone on the tax return, including children or other claimed dependents. Also, last year's tax return is helpful, if it's available.

AARP Tax-Aide volunteers can prepare most personal income tax returns, including those with basic self-employment income. They are not trained to do business returns such as corporate, partnership, limited partnership, farm income, or rental income. These types of returns are beyond the scope of the Tax-Aide program.

Topic: Accessibility and Affordability of Public Transit

You don't have to live in the city center to access the convenience of public transportation. In fact, public transit is closer to home than you may think. rabbittransit offers multiple forms of transportation throughout West Manchester Township and beyond.

rabbittransit provides regular weekday fixed route service between West Manchester Township and downtown York. Plus, the **1W route** has even more service to offer! With increased service frequency between the King Street Station and West Manchester Town Center, buses depart every 15 minutes during peak weekday hours. Cash fare is only \$1.60 one-way, and FREE for registered Senior Citizens. rabbittransit also offers a \$42 unlimited ride monthly pass – currently less than the average price of a tank of gas! To purchase discounted digital bus passes, download the Token Transit smartphone app at <a href="https://tokentransit.com/app">https://tokentransit.com/app</a>.

Unlike fixed route service, Shared Ride (a.k.a. Paratransit) service provides consolidated trips between travel origins and destinations during limited hours and specific areas. Use Shared Ride for trips to the doctor, your job or other life-sustaining service. If Shared Ride sounds like a fit for you, the first step is to submit an application. **Conveniently apply online by visiting www.rabbittransit.org > Shared Ride > How to apply.** 

All Shared Ride trips require a reservation. If you would like same-day service, you must make your reservation by 1:30 p.m. at least two hours prior to the trip. Otherwise, reservations must be made no later than 1:30 p.m. the business day before your ride. Reservations may be made two weeks in advance. For trips on Saturday, Sunday or Monday, reservations must be submitted by 1:30 p.m. the Friday before. Reservations may be made by calling rabbittransit Customer Service at 1-800-632-9063 or visiting www.FindMyRidePA.org.

**Keep in mind:** Shared Ride isn't a "taxi," meaning it isn't a non-stop ride for any one person. Different riders are grouped together depending on their travel time and location(s). Medical trips and/or appointments are given priority over trips for recreational purposes. Find more information at https://www.rabbittransit.org/services/shared-ride-paratransit/.
